#### **Conceptual Artist, Writer, Culture Researcher from Novi Sad (ECoC 2022), Serbia**

Ljiljana Maletin Vojvodic, with a Master's degree in literature, is a recognized Serbian conceptual artist, writer, culture researcher, literature teacher, editor-in-chief, and community art advocate from Novi Sad, Serbia, the first ECOC (2022) located outside of the EU. She is known for her profound exploration of Nordic cultures, the arts, and her unwavering passion for diverse cultures, contemporary visual art, women's contributions to the arts, and the portrayal of women in art, film, and literature.

## **Literary and Research Focus:**

Ljiljana's expertise spans various fields, including Scandinavian studies, image studies, gender studies, multiculturalism, women's art, the portrayal of women, intercultural dialogue, workshops with students, community art, photography, and art books. She actively engages in artist-in-residence programs and research projects on a global scale.

## **Notable Literary Works:**

Her portfolio comprises novels like "Skrik" (long listed for the most important literary award /NIN award/ in Serbia), "Those Who Eat Raw Meat", "Dwarves and Hyperborea", and "In Exile". She has also authored non-fiction narratives and insightful essays, covering topics from new art practices to the cultural image of Sweden in Serbian culture.

## **Awards and Recognitions:**

Ljiljana has received prestigious grants and awards, including grants from Novi Sad ECoC (2022, 2021), Q21, Vienna & Bundesministerium für Europa, Integration und Äußeres (2018), and the EU-Japan Fest Committee in cooperation with 'Novi Sad 2022' (2017, 2019). She has also received grants from NORLA, the Norwegian Literary Agency (2016), the Norwegian Embassy in Belgrade (2013), and the Finnish Embassy in Belgrade (2011), among others. Her works have found homes in libraries worldwide, including esteemed institutions such as the British Library, Library of Congress, Harvard Library, and Oslo City Library.

## **Artistic Exploration:**

Beyond her literary endeavors, Ljiljana has a profound interest in contemporary art and the contributions of women artists, with a keen focus on the gender perspective in contemporary art. She approaches these subjects through a cultural and post-feminist lens, often drawing from personal experiences and referencing women visual artists,

writers, and directors. Her work delves into the interplay of different cultures, prompting extensive travels to comprehend these intricate relationships.

### **Cross-Cultural Engagement:**

Ljiljana Maletin Vojvodic's dedication to cross-cultural interactions, her exploration of contemporary art, and her focus on female artists make her work distinctly unique in Serbian literature. Her writings serve as bridges between nations and cultures, aiming to understand both the commonalities and divisions that shape identities. Research and travel remain essential components of her artistic journey, providing her with the inspiration and perspective necessary to create meaningful and impactful literary works. Notably, her experience as a writer-in-residence at the Upernivik Museum in Arctic Greenland stands as a remarkable achievement, highlighting her commitment to cross-cultural engagement.
